The context is different between Commissioners and everyone else (members of public, staff, presenters). • Virtual Attendance by Commissioners: In cases of sickness or health, commissioners can join virtually and not have to provide notice or access of their location to the public. They are allowed this one time this year. • Virtual Access by Members of the Public: everyone else has the right to access meeting virtually. Commissioners may join virtually and follow the Brown Act by posting location and making it accessible to public (ADA compliance). If they are not able to follow Brown Act, they can join the meeting virtually as a member of the public (and no vote).
